At a recent Peace Feast where Muslims and non-Muslims shared dinner and a low-key presentation about Islam, three Saudi Arabian students who were also

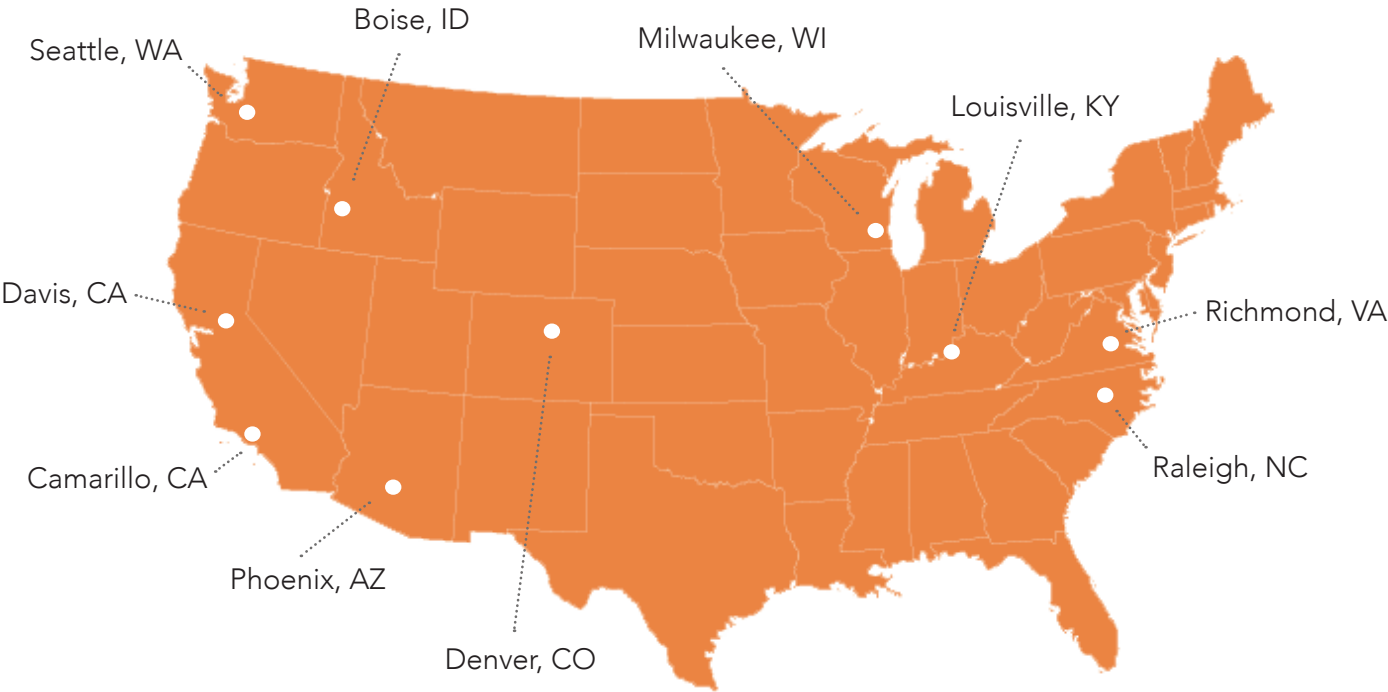

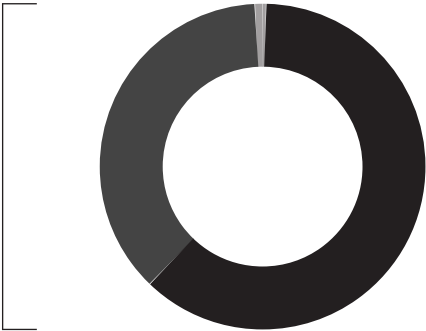

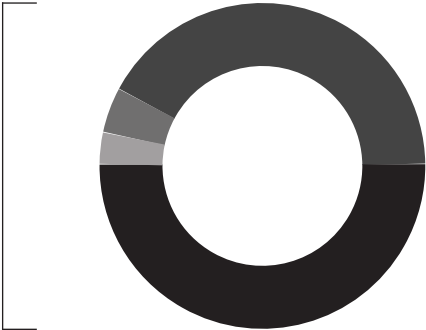
